## 1. Babysitting Clinic: May 2 & 4; May 16 & 18

Brule County Extension is hosting two sessions of babysitting clinics. They will be held the following times:

- May 2 & 4; 5:30-8:30 PM at Brule County Courthouse
- May 16 & 18; 5:30-8:30 PM at Brule County Courthouse

This clinic will be available to all youth 11 and up. The cost of the class will be \$10. Skills taught include basic safety, health snack prep, important facts about how kids grow and change, babysitter responsibilities and business basics, age appropriate activities for children and much more. Each youth will also get CPR/First Aid certification. Everyone will receive a babysitter's bag full of activities to take along with them.

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# 3. Animals Entry into 4-H Online—Beginning April 1

4-H Online will open on April 1<sup>st</sup> for animal entry. The deadline for entering animals into 4-H Online is June 1<sup>st</sup> at 11:59 PM. A couple tips when uploading animals:

- Only input animals into 4-H Online once and only under one youth (if you are unsure which child is showing what, there is a "family sharing" option when you sign up for achievement days where all animals under your family will show up)
- The only paperwork needed to be uploaded to 4-H Online before June 1 is animal lease papers.
- YLL & YHL certifications will be marked by the county office once the training has been completed. No certificate is necessary.
- Registration Papers: Registration papers for any breeds will only need to be uploaded to FairEntry when registering for the State Fair. Otherwise they will need to be shown as Crossbred/Commercial

## 4. Cupcake Wars:

Cupcake Wars is a contest at the county level that allows youth to express their creativity through designing a cupcake display. Once they register for the event they will receive a mystery theme that their display must be centered around. The youth are responsible to bring everything needed for this contest. Youth may participate either as individuals or as a team up to 3 members. Please see the Cupcake Booklet for rules and guidelines.

Cupcake Wars will be held Saturday, April 22 at Reliance Town Hall, Check-In at 10:00 AM.

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# 5. State Shooting Sports Registration is Open Until April 16

State Shoot sign up is open. Registration will close April 16. State Shoot will be in Ft. Pierre, April 28-30, 2023. A couple things to double check before signing up:

- 1. Please login to your 4-H Online account and make sure your child has each shooting sports discipline selected underneath your child's project areas. (Archery, BB, Pistol, Rifle, CMP participants will need to have Rifle selected) I believe I have made sure everyone has the correct disciplines added if they were missing, but please double check before Thursday, otherwise your registration will be delayed if it is wrong.

## 8. Youth Horse Literacy (Formally known as Horse Safety)

#### **Procedure**

- Enroll youth and projects in 4-H Online
  - -Upload horse animal information and photographs
  - -Upload lease form, if applicable.
- Complete at least one YHL certified event.
  - -If attending the event in your own 4-H county, be sure to sign in at registration

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-If attending a YLL event out-of-county, you will provide attendance certificate to your home 4-H county's Extension Office.

-Upload certificate into 4-H Online under Youth Horse Literacy upload tab.

-If applicable to your species, get animals tagged with 4-H ear tags and DNA pulled and submitted.
Complete at least one YLL certified event.
-If attending the event in your own 4-H county, be sure to sign in at registration
-If attending a YLL event out-of-county, you will provide attendance certificate to your home 4-H county's Extension Office.
-If using YQCA Online as your YLL event, you will convey completion certificate to your home 4-H county's Extension Office.
